DISCUSS

Talk through your thoughts.

- Animals have adaptations that help them hide to survive. What types of adaptations do you think humans have developed that have helped them to survive throughout history?
- Which of the animals in this book have the best camouflage? Which was the hardest to see in the photograph?

CREATE

Make an experience of your own.

- Try this camouflage activity:
Materials: 2 large sheets of construction paper in each of three different colors, Scissors, A partner
Procedure: Cut one sheet of each color into 2-inch by 2-inch squares. Place all of the colored squares onto one of the large sheets while your partner closes his eyes. When your partner opens his eyes, give him five seconds to grab as many colored squares as he can.
- Invent your own camouflaged animal. Decide your animals' habitat, then decide how it will hide in its habitat. (see Page 29)
